<b>DAY 1</b>	<b>THURSDAY, MARCH 15</b> DEPARTURE	Tonight you will head to the airport for an early morning departure.  <i>Overnight: Flight    Meals: Per Flight</i>
<b>DAY 2</b>	<b>FRIDAY, MARCH 16</b> MT NEBO JORDAN RIVER DEAD SEA	We will arrive in Amman at 10:30am local time ready to formally begin what will be an exciting adventure! Our first stop for the day will be a visit to Mt Nebo. We will enjoy a wonderful lunch together before heading to the Dead Sea where you will be able to float and relax and maybe even treat yourself to a dead sea mask! Followed by dinner at the hotel before a much needed goodnights sleep.  <i>Overnight: Holiday Inn, Dead Sea - L D</i>
<b>DAY 3</b>	<b>SATURDAY, MARCH 17</b> THE ROSE CITY	Today we will have an early start as we drive to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the Rose City of Petra. Which we will access through a hidden arrow Siq where the rocks will finally give way to reveal the famous facade of the Treasury. There are plenty of adventures to be had as you explore the hectares of ruins the Amphitheatre, temples, synagogue, tombs and more. You may wish to ride a horse to the entrance of the Siq to enhance your Petra experience. Lunch is on your own today. At the end of the day we will return to the Dead Sea.  <i>Overnight: Holiday Inn, Dead Sea - B D</i>
<b>DAY 4</b>	<b>SUNDAY, MARCH 18</b> JERICHO EIN GEDI DEAD SEA	Today we cross the border into the Holy Land. A drive by Tel Jericho and a cable car ride up Mount of Temptation where we will view the beauty of the Jordan Valley, we will have a must stop at the glorious Sycamore Tree of Jericho followed by some street duty free shopping. Ein Gedi is the place where David hid from King Saul, this oasis is amazing where you can explore the fresh water springs or walk the goat trails of the Ibex, its really is a beautiful oasis so put on your hiking boots as we explore the Wilderness of Judah.  <i>Overnight: Oasis Hotel, Jericho - B L D</i>

<b>DAY 5</b>	<b>MONDAY, MARCH 19</b> CAPERNAUM BEATITUDES WATER BAPTISM	The morning we will drive to Galilee to experience Capernaum, Jesus' headquarters during His ministry years. Here, we will also visit the Mount of Beatitudes where He gave the most famous sermon in the world! For lunch we will enjoy a local favorite, St Peter's Fish, which is sure to delight your palate. Finally, for those wanting to be water baptized in the Jordan River, an unforgettable experience awaits you.  <i>Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias - B L D</i>
<b>DAY 6</b>	<b>TUESDAY, MARCH 20</b> MT BENTEL TEL DAN SEA OF GALILEE	We begin our day heading far north to the Golan Heights where we will stop at the lower viewpoint of Mt Bental that overlooks Syria and Mt Hermon. Then, we head to Tel Dan where the Children of Israel built the Golden Calf and where the cool water from the ice-capped Mt Hermon begins their journey into the Jordan River. We will end the day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.  <i>Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias - B L D</i>
<b>DAY 7</b>	<b>WEDNESDAY, MARCH 21</b> NAZARETH ARMEGEDDON CAESARIA AQUADUCT	Today we will walk through the Nazareth Village which depicts life in the time of Jesus to learn what life was like by then. Not too far away is Mt Precipice which overlooks the Valley of Armageddon . After lunch we will head to the Mederterrainean Sea and Caesarea where Paul was held prisoner as well as the famous Roman Aquaduct which was built by Herod.  <i>Overnight: Manager Square Hotel, Bethlehem - B L D</i>
<b>DAY 8</b>	<b>THURSDAY, MARCH 22</b> MT OF OLIVES SIFTING PROJECT CHURCH OF NATIVITY	Today begins with an early morning visit to the Mt of Olives, which offers priceless views of the city of Jerusalem. From the top of the Mount we will begin the Palm Sunday walk down the steep incline to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. At the end of the walk is the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus was betrayed. Next, we have a special treat at the David City Sifting Project where you can sift through the buckets of dirt from under the Temple Mount looking for artifacts spread across 2000 years! Maybe you will find something special! If time permits you can explore the Old City on your own before we head back to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity.  <i>Overnight: Manger Square Hotel, Bethlehem - B L D</i>

<b>DAY 9</b>	<b>FRIDAY, MARCH 23</b> TEMPLE MOUNT WESTERN WALL HOLY SEPULCHRE HEZIEKIAH'S TUNNEL	<p>If conditions permit, we have an early start to visit the Temple Mount. It sits on top of Mount Moriah, 14 hectares of sacred space and is the most priceless piece of real estate in the world! The Temple Mount is where Abraham almost sacrificed his son, Isaac and the location of the Temples of Solomon and Herod; the latter is where the infant Jesus was presented before the Lord by Mary and Joseph. Next, we will make our way to the Western Wall, via the Holy Sepulchre, to pray and, if you like, place a hand written prayer in the crevices of the stones. Next, we will get to walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel, always a highlight!</p> <p><i>Overnight: Manger Square Hotel    Meals: B L D</i></p>
<b>DAY 10</b>	<b>SATURDAY, MARCH 24</b> CAESAREA SHILOH YAD VA SHEM GARDEN TOMB	<p>This morning we will drive to Shiloh where the Tabernacle was located for 356 years, this is also where Hanna prayed for a son. We then return to Jerusalem to visit Nad Va Shem where we remember those we lost in the Holocaust. Finally, we will enjoy communion together at the Garden Tomb which is always a very moving experience. After we check into our hotel, the rest of the day is yours to enjoy!</p> <p><i>Overnight: Caesar Hotel, Jerusalem - B L D</i></p>
<b>DAY 11</b>	<b>SUNDAY, MARCH 25</b> JERUSALEM AMMAN	<p>Today you can go out and explore Jerusalem on your own! A short walk from the hotel will take you to the Old City or you can hang out at the local shops on Jaffa Road. Today lunch is on your own so enjoy some local food!</p> <p>Later today we head to the border to return to Jordan followed by a drive-by of Amman stopping at the Amman Looking out.</p> <p><i>Overnight: Geneva Hotel, Amman - B L D</i></p>
<b>DAY 12</b>	<b>MONDAY, MARCH 26</b> AMMAN	<p>Today we return home so we head to the airport for a Mid-morning flight via Doha arriving in KL at 8:05am on 27<sup>th</sup> March.</p> <p>Overnight: Flight - Meals: B only meals on flight.</p>

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read the following 'Terms & Conditions' carefully because your acceptance of them is required in order to participate in the 'Grace Adventure Tour'.

**DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT:** In order to secure your place on the 'Grace Adventure Tour' a deposit of **USD \$1000 per person** is payable at the time of booking, along with a signed 'booking form.' Each participant needs to fill out their own 'Booking Form,' even if they are traveling as a couple/family (underage children can be covered by their parent's form). You will be given a confirmation of booking as well as a request for the balance of monies owed. The balance of payment needs to be sent no later than 15 February, 2018. Failure to pay the balance by the due date means that we have the right to deem your booking as 'cancelled' and a cancellation fee will apply.

**SINGLE-SUPPLEMENT:** The tour land arrangements are based on 'twin share,' namely, two people sharing one hotel room. If a person is traveling alone and wants a room to them self, a 'single-supplement' extra charge must be paid. If a person is traveling alone, wants to go 'twin-share,' we will make every effort to identify a suitable partner. However, if no partner can be found, the 'single-supplement' charge still applies.

**GROUP TOUR:** The costs of the land arrangements are based on **15 people** traveling together, unless specified otherwise. Should less than this number be signed up, we reserve the right to adjust the price, cancel the tour or give a refund.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** You are **strongly** advised to obtain travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit. Your policy should include, but not be limited to cancellation, loss of deposit, loss of baggage, medical expenses, costs of repatriation to your home country if the tour is cut short or extended due to illness, or costs of returning to home country outside the tour due to the serious illness or death of a loved one. Please note that the 'Grace Adventure Tour'. Teach All Nations Inc. and GEMM International Tours & Travel are not responsible for the expenses of uninsured travelers.

**LAND ARRANGEMENTS:** All travel and accommodation is provided to tour participants by reputable third parties through GEMM International Tours & Travel, therefore it is important to remember that your place on the tour is subject to the liabilities and limitations imposed by these third parties.

**COOPERATION:** Participants are traveling to the Middle East as Biblical tourists/pilgrims. Therefore, it is imperative, and required, that full cooperation be given to the tour leader at all times.

**PHOTOGRAPHY:** Many photos are taken during the 'Grace Adventure Tour' Photos taken by us are sometimes used in promotion and or educational purposes. By signing the booking form you are agreeing that in the event that you are in any of these photos and it is used by Teach All Nations Inc. for promotion and educational that you have granted your permission.

**CHRISTIAN PILGRIMAGE: 'Grace Adventure Tour'** is a Biblical tour open to members of the Body of Christ at large. It has a Charismatic flavor. Because this is a journey to Biblical sites for the purpose of devotion and education, all participants are required to honor Biblical/ Christian/ traditional standards of morality and ethics at all times. Those who are physically impaired must have a care-giver traveling with them and assisting them at all times. Under-aged children are to be under the control of their parents at all times.

**CANCELLATION:** Should you find it necessary to cancel your reservation, you must advise us in writing. The letter of cancellation needs to be signed by the person making the original booking. No cancellation will be deemed active until the signed letter is received. Cancellation charges will be levied, depending on how much money was spent on your reservation and how close to the departure time the cancellation was made. They can vary from 30%, 60% or even 100% of the amount paid. Remember that cancellation charges might be compensated to you by your insurance company, depending on the reasons for the cancellation.
