# TOUR ITINERARY

## WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 15 - DAY ONE:

### KUALA LAMPUR/MELBOURNE – DOHA – ATHENS

Where ever you live, plan to arrive in Athens on this day. There will be an airport transfer to the hotel (for those on tour sponsored flights). The rest of the day is free, dinner on your own.

## THURSDAY NOVEMBER 16 - DAY TWO:

### OLD CORINTH, MYCENAE

After breakfast at the hotel we will begin our journey to Corinth. Our first stop will be at the famous Corinth Canal which connects the Aegean Sea with the Ionian Sea. Next, we will get to explore Ancient Corinth and all it has to offer. It is here that the Apostle Paul lived for two years and penned the epistles I & II Corinthians, which have blessed the world for two millenia. After lunch, we will stop at Mycenae and visit the Treasury of Atreus and the Archaeological Site with the famous Lion Gate and the Cyclopean Walls.

## FRIDAY NOVEMBER 17 - DAY THREE:

### ATHENS

Today we will explore the wonderful city of Athens. Athens is not just the capital city of Greece but it is the birthplace of western civilisation. We will get to see iconic sites like the Acropolis, the Parthenon and the Erechtheion, accompanied by the magnificent view from the hill of the city where Paul preached his famous sermon (Acts 17:15-34). After lunch we will visit the Agora, the Acropolis Museum and the famous Plaka, with it's sparkling multitude of shops and attractions. Finally we will visit for the small church of Notre Kapnikareas, a leading Byzantine monument in the center of Ermou, and the Athens Cathedral "Metropoleos".

## SATURDAY NOVEMBER 18 - DAY FOUR:

### OSIOS LUCAS, DELPHI

Our first stop today will be a visit to the UNESCO World Heritage site of the Monastery of St. Luke (Osios Lucas) one of the most important examples of Byzantine art and architecture. We will also visit the famous archaeological site of Delphi, known in ancient times' for its mystical energy and the power of the god Apollo. On Mount Parnassus, in a landscape of immense beauty, are the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo and the Museum, which are rich in ancient sculpture masterpieces such as the bronze Charioteer. After lunch we will make our way to Kalambaka where we will stay over night.

## SUNDAY NOVEMBER 19 - DAY FIVE:

### METEORE, VERGINA, THESSALONIKI

This morning we will visit the Meteors. In a unique setting, on top of huge rocks and hanging between the earth and the sky, there are the famous Monasteries considered to be unique examples of Byzantine art, who guard. After lunch we will visit the small town of Vergina which became famous in 1977, when the Greek archaeologist Manolis Andronikos unearthed what he said was the site of the kings of Macedonia. Buried among the graves was the tomb of Philip II, father of Alexander the Great; one of the most influential people in history. We will visit the museum that was built in order to protect these tombs, exhibit the artefacts and show the mound as it was before the excavations. The two main tombs on display still preserved all the treasures deposited in them at the time of burial, finds that can be admired in the museum. After the visit we will go to a small hill in the town of Berea - as described in the Bible; where tradition holds that the Apostle Paul preached. Paul won many souls here but also stirred up intense opposition (Acts 17:10-14). A small shrine, known as the Altar of St. Paul, was erected in this place to commemorate the apostle. We will finish the day in Thessaloniki where we will stay overnight.

## MONDAY NOVEMBER 20 - DAY SIX:

### PHILIPPI, KAVALA, THESSALONIKI

Today we will make our way to Phillippi along the "Egnatia" road built on the trail of the ancient Roman road. On the drive we will be able to admire the lakes of Volvi and Koroni and the village of Asprovalta, where we will make a quick stop to visit the famous statue of the Lion of Amphipolis. Next, we will visit the site where Lydia, the first Christian woman in Europe was baptized and then proceed to the archaeological site of Phillippi with its Roman Forum which hosts the remains of two early Christian basilicas; the prison where he was held Saint Paul in 50 AD and the ancient Greek Theatre. Phillippi is prominently mentioned in Acts 16 and is also where Paul penned the joyful Epistle to the Philippians. We will drive to the stunningly beautiful city of Kavala on the Aegean also known as ancient Neapolis, where Paul first entered Europe - Acts 16:11-12. We will have a brief tour of the city and its port.

## TUESDAY NOVEMBER 21 - DAY SEVEN:

### THESSALONIKI – ATHENS

After breakfast, we will embark on a sightseeing tour of Thessaloniki, the recipient of the epistles, I & II Thessalonians. Some of our stops will include: the White Tower; the Byzantine church of Agios Demetrius, Vlatados Monastery, also known as the Monasteries Tsaous with a rich history it is the only Monastery in the city of the Byzantine period built in the mid-fourteenth century. and remained active to this day. According to local tradition, the monastery was built on the place where the Apostle Paul preached and lived during his stay in the city.

After lunch we will take a flight to Athens where we will be able to enjoy free time for the rest of the day.

## WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 22 - DAY EIGHT:

### FLIGHT ATHENS - ROME FB

Today is a full day of site seeing! After breakfast we will catch our flight to Rome where we will spend the whole day exploring this beautiful and historical city. Some of the sites on the day's agenda include: the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Cathedral, the Trevi Fountain, the Piazza di Spagna, the Pantheon, the Piazza Navona, the Colosseum and the Foro Romano.

## THURSDAY NOVEMBER 23 - DAY NINE:

### ROME - POMPEII - ROME FB

After breakfast we will spend the morning exploring Pompeii, one of the most visited sites in Italy; Pompeii was listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1997. The site is a perfect representation of everyday life in first century before the city, its buildings and inhabitants, were buried by the eruption of Vesuvius. We will learn all about the history of the city, and its culture as we walk the so-called Street of Abundance, the most important street in the city, with important homes and popular shops. We will visit the huge amphitheater, designed to accommodate up to 20,000 people, and admire the beautifully preserved frescoes and marble decorations that tell us how Romans lived back in the first century AD. After lunch we will return to Rome and spend the rest of the day visiting St John Cathedral, Scala Santa and Cathedral of Virgin Mary.

## FRIDAY NOVEMBER 24 - DAY TEN:

### ROME CATACOMBS FB

Today we will visit some of the greatest and most important sites in Rome, St. Paul's Cathedral and The catacombs of St. Callixtus. In it were martyrs, popes and Christians. They are named after the deacon Callixtus who, at the beginning of the third century, was appointed by pope Zephyrinus as the administrator of the cemetery and so the catacombs of St. Callixtus became the official cemetery of the Church of Rome. We will transfer to the airport later in the day for our flights home.

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

**DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT:** In order to secure your place on the ' **In The Footsteps of Paul Tour**' a deposit of AUD \$1200 per person is payable at the time of booking, along with a signed 'booking form.' Each participant needs to fill out their own 'Booking Form,' even if they are traveling as a couple/family (underage children can be covered by their parent's form). You will be given a confirmation of booking as well as a request for the balance of monies owed. The balance of payment needs to be sent no later than 1 October, 2017 to the office. Failure to pay the balance by the due date means that we have the right to deem your booking as 'cancelled' and a cancellation fee will apply.

**SINGLE-SUPPLEMENT:** The tour land arrangements are based on 'twin share,' namely, two people sharing one hotel room. If a person is traveling alone and wants a room to them self, a 'single-supplement' extra charge must be paid. If a person is traveling alone, wants to go 'twin-share,' we will make every effort to identify a suitable partner. However, if no partner can be found, the 'single-supplement' charge still applies.

**GROUP TOUR:** The costs of the land arrangements are based on **25 people** traveling together, unless specified otherwise. Should less than this number be signed up, we reserve the right to adjust the price, cancel the tour or give a refund.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** You are strongly advised to obtain travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit. Your policy should include, but not be limited to cancellation, loss of deposit, loss of baggage, medical expenses, costs of repatriation to your home country if the tour is cut short or extended due to illness, or costs of returning to home country outside the tour due to the serious illness or death of a loved one. Please note that the '**In The Footsteps of Paul Tour**' Teach All Nations Inc. and GEMM International Tours & Travel are not responsible for the expenses of uninsured travellers.

**LAND ARRANGEMENTS:** All travel and accommodation is provided to tour participants by reputable third parties through GEMM International Tours & Travel, therefore it is important to remember that your place on the tour is subject to the liabilities and limitations imposed by these third parties.

**COOPERATION:** Participants are traveling to the Middle East as Biblical tourists/pilgrims. Therefore, it is imperative, and required, that full cooperation be given to the tour leader at all times.

Because this is a journey to Biblical sites for the purpose of devotion and education, all participants are required to honor Biblical/ Christian/ traditional standards of morality and ethics at all times. Those who are physically impaired must have a care-giver traveling with them and assisting them at all times. Under-aged children are to be under the control of their parents at all times.

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

**CANCELLATION:** Should you find it necessary to cancel your reservation, you must advise us in writing. The letter of cancellation needs to be signed by the person making the original booking. No cancellation will be deemed active until the signed letter is received. Cancellation charges will be levied, depending on how much money was spent on your reservation and how close to the departure time the cancellation was made. They can vary from 30%, 60% or even 100% of the amount paid. Remember that cancellation charges might be compensated to you by your insurance company, depending on the reasons for the cancellation.

**REFUNDS:** Refunds will not be given once the tour has commenced, nor will they be given if a part of the tour was not utilized, including those arranged by a third party.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** We will do our utmost to coordinate this tour for the benefit of all and accept responsibility for those actions that are a direct result of our negligence. **TRANSFERS:** Pilgrims who come on the tour endorsed flights have their airport transfers included in the land price. However, if a pilgrim arranges their own flights and arrive at a time different to that of the group, they are liable for an additional cost to cover their transfer from the airport to the hotel. Likewise, if at the end of the tour, they require to get to the airport sooner or later than the group, again, an additional cost for transfer will be levied.

**LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:** The participant agrees that in no event will the tour operator be liable for the results of participant's use of these services, for participant's inability or failure to obtain business or customers, or for indirect, special, or consequential damages. Participants further agrees that in no event will the total aggregate liability of the tour operator for any claims, losses or damages arising under this agreement whether in contract or tort, exceed the total amount paid by the participant to the tour operator during the preceding twelve (12) month period, even if the tour participant to tour operator has been advised of the possibility of such claim, loss, or damage except for losses arising from the tour operator's gross negligence, fraud, or willful misconduct. The foregoing limitation of liability and exclusion of certain damages shall apply regardless of the success or effectiveness of other remedies.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws (excluding the law of conflict of laws) of the State of Victoria, Commonwealth of Australia. All disputes shall be resolved in Melbourne, Victoria. Failure to deal with the problem promptly could make matters worse. If it involves the hotel and problems with the room, please see the front desk. Only if you cannot get satisfaction with the hotel that you should see a responsible tour person (tour guide is the first person to ask). We will do our very best to resolve issues on the spot. 2. In the unlikely event that you need to write about an issue, you have 28 days after the completion of the tour to document the problem. You can expect an initial response within 14-28 days after the letter is received. Any letters received after 28 days will be deemed 'late.' No action will be taken or response sent.
