FLIGHT INFORMATION

Flights are ***not*** included in the tour cost. Each traveler is responsible for booking their flights and travel insurance. ***Travel insurance is strongly recommended, and covid coverage is required to enter Israel.*** Insurance should be purchased at the same time if not before, you book your flights.

In order to catch the free group transfer from the airport to the hotel, you must arrive no later than 10:30am Tuesday, January 31st. If you arrive after this time you will need to make your own way to the hotel. We do ask that everyone be at dinner, at the hotel, at 6 pm on the 31st. If you arrive before the 31st of January you will be responsible for your own accommodations - which we can help you with.

The flight departure on February 11, is 5:30 am. If your flight departs later we can help you arrange your transfer to the airport which is an additional cost to you. There is a train from Jerusalem to the TLV terminal for about US\$10

TOUR ITINERARY:

Monday, January 30 - Saturday, February 11

PETRA ADDITION: Saturday, February 11 - Tuesday February 14

Day 0 - Monday, January 30th - Tuesday, January 31st

Your journey begins as you depart Spokane. For most of you, it is your first visit to the region and you will not be disappointed! Now is the time to sit back, relax and enjoy your flight as we have some very full and exciting days ahead!

Once you arrive in Tel Aviv, and clear customs, our guide will be waiting for the main group at baggage claim. Once everyone has collected their bags you will be escorted to the bus that will take you straight to the Grand Beach Hotel.

You will have the afternoon to yourself to enjoy by the hotel pool, explore Tel Aviv, or catch up on sleep.

Dinner will be at the hotel at 6 pm followed by an introductory tour meeting.

Overnight: Grand Beach Hotel, Tel Aviv

Included meals: D

Day 1 - Wednesday, February 1: Caesarea II Tel Meggido II Mount Arbel

This morning we depart the Tel Aviv area and drive north to the Herodian-built city and port of Caesarea, home of Cornelius, Philip the evangelist, and Pontius Pilate. You will see the remains of Herod's theatre, his palace (partially buried beneath the sea), and the Hippodrome where chariot races took place.

In the afternoon we will take a short drive to see the aqueduct and also dip your toe in the Mediterranean Sea. We will visit the archaeological site of Megiddo, better known to the world as 'Armageddon.' After we have a panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee at Mount Arbel, we will make our home in Tiberias for the next four nights.

Day 2 - Thursday, February 2: Mount Carmel Assembly II Nazareth Village II Mt Precipice

This morning we visit Mount Carmel, the mountain range that served as a border between the Israelites and Phoenicians. It was the place where Elijah challenged and defeated the prophets of Baal. We will enjoy some Messianic worship at the Mount Carmel Assembly. Following that we will visit the popular 'Nazareth Village,' a reconstruction of Nazareth in the time of Jesus. Just outside the city is Mount Precipice - the traditional site of the 'brow of the hill' where Jesus was nearly killed. The view of the Armageddon Valley is spectacular!

Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias

Day 3 - Friday, February 3: Capernaum II Mount of Beatitudes II Sea of Galilee II Yardenit

This morning we visit Capernaum, Jesus' hometown during His ministry, and the Mount of Beatitudes; the location of the most famous sermon in the world.

A real highlight is the boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, where you can worship and reflect on its rich biblical history. If possible, we will enjoy a St. Peter's Fish Lunch (don't worry - non-fish is available, too) near the lake.

After lunch, we will go to the Jordan River, where you can be baptized (or rededicate your baptism) at Yardenit, a beautiful Christian baptism site where the Sea of Galilee flows into the Jordan River. Once done we will head back to the hotel and the rest of your day is free to explore Tiberias.

Day 4 - Saturday, February 4: Golan Heights II Tel Dan II Banias

We start the day at Mitzpe Shalom on the magnificent southern Golan Heights; right at the edge of a basalt precipice, overlooking a breathtaking panoramic landscape of the Sea of Galilee, the Galilee Mountains, the peak of Mount Tabor and the fields of the Jordan Valley.

Next, we head to Mount Bental on the Damascus Road near the Syrian border. This inactive volcano delivers great views of Lebanon, Israel, and Syria which is just a stone's throw away. Also, Mount Hermon, Mount Avital, and the Syrian town of Quneitra are nearby. Mount Bental will also provide one with a keener appreciation of the strategic significance of the Golan Heights.

From here we continue north to Tel Dan, the ancient Biblical city of the tribe of Dan, and the northernmost point of Old Testament Israel. The altar for Jeroboam's golden calf (1 Kings 12) is still there. Nearby is the newly discovered 'Abraham's Gate.' Nearby is Banias, known as Caesarea-Philippi in the New Testament, where Peter confessed Jesus as the Messiah. It was here that the Lord used the word 'church' for the first time.

Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias

Day 5 - Sunday, February 5: Beit Shean II Jordan River II Jericho

Today we depart Galilee and head south to Jericho. Along the way, we will visit Beit Shean where Saul & Jonathan's bodies were hung on the wall by the Philistines after their defeat at Mount Gilboa (1 Samuel 31). Beit Shean is an outstanding and well-preserved archaeological site with impressive Hellenistic remains. We will stop at the Jordan River near Jesus' baptismal site and you will be just meters/yards from the Kingdom of Jordan. Finally, we will arrive at Jericho, the oldest city in the world.

Overnight: Oasis Hotel, Jericho

Meals: B D

Day 6 - Monday, February 6: Jericho II Qumran II Dead Sea Beach

This morning we explore Jericho, the city of Rahab, Joshua, Bartimaeus, and Zacchaeus. We will take a cable car ride over the remains of Jericho to the Mount of Temptation where you will see the Jordan Valley and the nation of Jordan in the distance.

After lunch, we will visit Qumran the location of the Dead Sea Scrolls; the greatest literary discovery of the twentieth century. We will enjoy the afternoon floating on the Dead sea.

Overnight: Oasis Hotel, Jericho Meals: B D

Day 7 - Tuesday, February 7: Ein Gedi II Masada

Today we make our way south through the Judea Wilderness and Rift Valley as we head to En Gedi and Masada. En Gedi is a beautiful oasis and nature reserve with waterfalls and ponds very close to the Dead Sea. It was where David hid from Saul in a cave and cut off the corner of his garment - and regretted it (1 Samuel 24:1-8).

Next is Masada, Herod's fortress in the wilderness with a self-contained and well-preserved community at the top of the mountain. Despite the scarcity of rain, they had filled cisterns; learn how! The Dead Sea is on one side and the Judean wilderness is on the other. It was here the Jewish Zealots defied the Roman legion for almost three years, only to commit mass suicide rather than surrender. Their story is told by Josephus Flavius and also became a blockbuster movie.

Overnight: Manger Square Hotel, Bethlehem

Day 8 - Wednesday, February 8: Church of the Nativity II Herodian II Mt. Zion II Upper Room

Today focuses on the Bethlehem area and Jerusalem. We will visit the Church of the Nativity, the traditional site of Christ's birth. If time permits, we will visit Herodian, a 'mini-Masada' where they buried Herod the Great. Next, we go to nearby Mount Zion in Jerusalem to visit the church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu, where Peter denied Christ three times. We will also visit the Upper Room - the traditional location of the Last Supper.

Overnight: Manger Square Hotel, Bethlehem

Day 9 - Thursday, February 9: Old City of Jerusalem II Temple Mount II Western Wall II Garden Tomb II Temple Tunnel

We have an early start as we begin the day at the Temple Mount (if conditions permit) which is the remains of the temple mount platform and the current place of the Dome of the Rock. View the Golden Gate and Mt of Olives from here. It is a short walk to the Western Wall which is the remains of the temple mount's outer retaining wall. Jews and their Christian friends come to pray here. We will explore the Temple Tunnel that takes us 400 meters underground to the bedrock of the Old City walls built by Herod and to the streets that Jesus would have walked. We will visit the Garden Tomb - the traditional site of Jesus' burial. We will also have Holy Communion here.

Overnight: Caesar Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 10 - Friday, February 10: Mt of Olives II Sifting Project II City of David II Hezekiah's Tunnel

Today we head to the Mt of Olives and view the City of Jerusalem with a breathtaking panorama. A slow walk down the Palm Sunday Road will bring us to Dominus Flevit where Jesus Wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41-44). Further down the Mount of Olives, we come to the Church of All Nations, known as the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed before he was arrested. It was here that His passion began. In the afternoon we will visit the City of David, the original Jerusalem, which David captured from the Jebusites (2 Samuel 5). We will also experience one of the great highlights of the tour as we walk through the 500-meter Biblical Hezekiah's Tunnel (it's knee-deep in water), built in 701 BC, to channel Jerusalem's water from the Gihon Springs to the Pool of Siloam. The Sifting Centre is a fun opportunity to sift through the dirt taken from archaeological sites under the Temple Mount. We will be looking for artifacts - it's a fun activity for all - maybe you will find something special. At the end of the day take the opportunity to wander the Old City on your own, a 30-minute walk through West Jerusalem's shopping area will return you to our hotel.

Day 11 - Saturday, February 11: Travel Home II Petra Extension

Today we say goodbye to those heading home who have a very, very early morning departure from the hotel. The rest of us will continue to Petra, heading to the Allenby Bridge where we cross the border into Jordan and enjoy a 4-hour drive to Petra.

Overnight: Petra Guest House, Petra

Day 12 - Sunday, February 12: Petra

Petra is Jordan's number one tourist site. It is a one-of-a-kind experience located in the mountains of Edom, Esau's inheritance.

Petra is a city carved out of the rock that goes for 262 kilometers (163 miles). You enter Petra through the narrow canyon called *The Siq*, 1.2 kilometers long, that eventually leads to the iconic Treasury, which is the Tomb of King Aretas, mentioned in the Bible (2 Corinthians 11:32). If you are fit enough, hike up to the high place or the thousand steps to the Monastery. You will never forget Petra!

Overnight: Petra Guest House, Petra
Meals: B D

Day 13 - Monday, February 13: The Old City

After breakfast, we will head back to Jerusalem via the Allenby Bridge. Tonight we will stay in the Old City, for the last time. If you have the energy, you're free to explore. Dinner is not included tonight; however, there are plenty of delicious Arab cafes to choose from. Enjoy your last hours in the City of the Great King. You have a very early departure time in the morning so a good night's sleep is in order.

Overnight: Imperial Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 14 - Tuesday, February 14: Departure

We will be departing the hotel at 1:30 am. It will be too early for breakfast, but you can pick something up at the airport, as you wait to catch your flight home. You will be taking with you memories that will last a lifetime!

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read the following carefully before booking – your signed booking form with the deposit will be deemed as full acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

GENERAL: For the purposes of these booking terms and conditions the following definitions will apply: 'we/us/our' is Teach All Nations Inc, the tour organizer; 'you/your' is the person who has signed the booking form, 'participant' is any person (including children) who forms part of the tour group.

BOOKING, DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT: In order to secure a place on the '**Freedom Tour 2023**' each participant aged 10 or over must fill out their own 'Booking Form,' even if they are traveling as a couple or family (underage children can be included on a parent's form). The signed booking form(s) should be sent together with a non-refundable deposit of **USD 500** per person for Israel Only or **USD 600** for Israel and Petra. The booking cannot be considered definite until you have received a confirmation email/letter. The balance of payment must be sent no later than **13 December 2022** to the office. We reserve the right to cancel your booking and apply a cancellation fee if the balance is not paid by the due date. If your money is sent to a third party (e.g. church office), it is the responsibility of that party until the time it is received by the tour organizer's office. We will not be liable for the money until we receive a confirmed balance in our account.

EXCHANGE RATES: The cost of the tour is based on United States Dollars (USD). If you pay for the tour in your own national currency, please bear in mind that the final price will be based on the USD exchange rate at the time that we make the final payment to the local travel agent - GEMM - which is not the same date as your final payment to us (Teach All Nations). Should the exchange rate change by more than 2% from the time of your final payment to us and our final payment to GEMM Travel, you may be asked to pay a currency supplement charge. You can avoid any exchange rate surprises by making your final payment in USD.

SINGLE-SUPPLEMENT CHARGE: The tour land arrangements are based on 'twin share' (two people sharing one hotel room). If you are traveling alone and want a single room, a 'single-supplement' extra charge must be paid. If you are traveling alone and are willing to 'twin-share' with a fellow traveler please indicate this on the booking form and we will make every effort to identify a suitable partner. However, if no partner can be found, the 'single-supplement' charge will still apply.

GROUP TOUR: The costs of the land arrangements are based on **34 people** traveling together unless specified otherwise. Should less than this number sign up for the tour, we reserve the right to adjust the price, cancel the tour or give a refund. We will notify you two months in advance in the unlikely event of a cancellation.

ITINERARY: We plan to follow the advertised day-to-day itinerary as closely as possible, but we reserve the right to alter the itinerary at our sole discretion, for the purpose of serving the overall welfare of all the pilgrims on the tour, or if local conditions or circumstances mean that it is not possible or advisable to visit some of the advertised locations, or we deem that there is a better alternative.

FITNESS: We welcome participants of all ages but, whatever your age, you will require a reasonable level of fitness as a number of locations involve walking on rough ground, and exploring Jerusalem means climbing many sets of steps. If you are physically impaired you must have a caregiver traveling with you to assist you at all times.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: You are strongly advised to obtain travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit. Your policy should include, but not be limited to, cancellation, loss of deposit, loss of baggage, medical expenses, covid coverage, costs of repatriation to your home country if the tour is cut short or extended due to illness, or costs of returning to home country outside the tour due to the serious illness or death of a loved one. Please note that the '**Freedom Tour 2023,**' Teach All Nations Inc. (Australia, United Kingdom, United States), and GEMM International Tours & Travel will not be responsible for the expenses of uninsured travelers.

A health insurance policy with cover for the the treatment of covid is required .

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: All travel and accommodation are provided to tour participants by reputable third parties through GEMM International Tours & Travel, therefore it is important to remember that your place on the tour is subject to the liabilities and limitations imposed by these third parties.

TRANSFERS: The tour price includes one main group transfer at the beginning of the tour from the airport and also one at the end of the tour to the border and/or the airport. You must plan your own arrival and departure to coincide with the time periods we will give you. Should your flight or other travel arrangements be outside the arrival or departure time periods we give you, you will be liable to pay your own additional transfer costs. We will not make any pro-rata refund if you do not avail yourself of the transfer facility we provide.

PHOTOGRAPHY: During the tour, we may take photographs and these may be used by us for promotion and/or educational purposes. By signing the booking form you are agreeing that in the event that your image appears in any of these photos it may be used by Teach All Nations Inc. for promotion and/or educational purposes.

CHRISTIAN PILGRIMAGE & COOPERATION: Participants in the '**Freedom Tour 2023**' are traveling to the Middle East as Biblical tourists/pilgrims, and the tour is open to members of the Body of Christ at large. It has a Pentecostal/Charismatic flavor. Because this is a journey to Biblical sites for the purpose of devotion and education, all participants are required at all times to honor Biblical/ Christian/ traditional standards of morality and ethics and to fully cooperate with the tour leaders. Certain holy sites have modesty dress standards that must be respected - the pilgrim will be informed ahead of time, though they will not be required to wear formal attire. Underage children must be under the control of their parents at all times.

CANCELLATION: Should you find it necessary to cancel your reservation, you must advise us in writing. The letter of cancellation must be signed by the person making the original booking. No cancellation will be deemed effective until the signed letter is received. Cancellation charges will be levied, depending on how much money we have spent on your reservation and how close to the departure time the cancellation is received by us. Cancellation charges can vary from 30% to 100% of the amount paid. You may be entitled to reclaim any cancellation charges we make from your insurance company, depending on your reasons for the cancellation.

REFUNDS: Refunds will not be given once the tour has commenced, nor will they be given if a part of the tour was not utilized, including those parts arranged by a third party.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS: It is your responsibility to check and fulfill the passport, visa, health, and immigration requirements applicable to your itinerary. You must check requirements for your own specific circumstances with the relevant Embassies and/or Consulates and your own doctor as applicable. Requirements do change and you must check the up-to-date position in good time before departure. Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel.

RESPONSIBILITY: We will do our utmost to coordinate this tour for the benefit of all and accept responsibility for those actions that are a direct result of our actions or negligence. However, we cannot and will not accept liability of any kind for acts, defaults, omissions, by negligence, damage, loss, theft of luggage and personal injury, accident, or illness or otherwise, involving any aspect of the tour outside our control or by third parties. Furthermore, the '**Freedom Tour 2023**' will not accept responsibility for the following, including but not limited to: actions of airlines, local tour operators, hotel operators, coach drivers or coach companies, or any other person or company providing services for this tour. We do not accept liability in contract or in tort (actionable wrong) for injury, damage, loss, delay, additional expenses, or inconvenience caused, directly or not, whether by human error or an 'act of God' (force of nature), breakdown of equipment, strikes, theft, delay, cancellations or changes in itinerary or schedule, actions of the individual tourist, including failure to listen to instructions and warnings, or any other event beyond our control, or that cannot be stopped even by our due diligence, including but not limited to terrorism, fire, war, riots, floods, very severe weather, acts of nature, acts of government, or other authorities, accidents, or mechanical failures. Again, we stress the need for you to obtain travel insurance to protect you from the unexpected.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: The participant agrees that in no event will the tour operator and organizer (Teach All Nations) be liable for the results of the participant's use of these services, or for indirect, special, or consequential damages. Participant further agrees that in no event will the total aggregate liability of the tour operator and organizer for any claims, losses, or damages arising under this agreement whether in contract or tort, exceed the total amount paid by the participant to the tour organizer during the preceding twelve (12) month period, even if the tour operator and/or organizer has been advised of the possibility of such claim, loss, or damage except for losses arising from the tour operator's and/or organizer's gross negligence, fraud, or willful misconduct. The foregoing limitation of liability and exclusion of certain damages shall apply regardless of the success or effectiveness of other remedies.

COMPLAINTS: While we do our very best to serve the pilgrims under our charge, we live in an imperfect world and problems may arise. Should there be an issue, here is the protocol:

1. If there is an issue involving the tour, you should immediately bring it to the attention of the responsible person (tour guide, team leader, tour organizer, etc.) who will try to resolve the issue on the spot.
2. If there is an issue with the hotel and problems with the room, you should speak to the front desk of the hotel. If you cannot get satisfaction from the hotel you should then bring it to the attention of the responsible tour person (the tour guide is the first person to ask). We will do our best to assist in resolving the issue.
3. In the unlikely event that an issue cannot be resolved on the spot and you need to write to us about it, you should send us your written account within twenty-eight (28) days of the completion of the tour. You can expect an initial response from us within 14-28 days after your letter is received. Any letters received more than twenty-eight days after the tour has finished will be deemed 'late' and no action will be taken or response sent.

MISCELLANEOUS This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws (excluding the law of conflict of laws) of the State of Victoria, Commonwealth of Australia. All disputes shall be resolved in Melbourne, Victoria. THIS AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES THE COMPLETE AND EXCLUSIVE STATEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES CONCERNING THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS AGREEMENT. No representation or promise relating to and no amendment of this Agreement shall be binding unless it is in writing and signed by both parties. In the event that any of the provisions contained in this Agreement are held to be unenforceable, this Agreement shall be construed without such provisions. This Agreement shall remain in effect until further agreement of the parties.
