

EGYPT		
DAY 1	WEDNESDAY, February 21	You will depart your international city for your flight to Cairo Overnight: Royal Jordanian Airlines
DAY 2	THURSDAY, February 22	This morning we will arrive in beautiful Cairo and spend the rest of the day relaxing before dinner. You will need a good night sleep to be ready for the full and exciting days ahead! Lunch is not included today so you can eat in the hotel or try some real Egyptian food from the local street vendors. Overnight: Holiday Inn Hotel, Cairo - Meals: D
DAY 3	FRIDAY, February 23	We begin the day with the Great Pyramids of Cheops, Chefren, Mykerinus Memphis and Sakkara which are a marvellous sight to behold. For an addition USD \$15 you can enter the pyramids and walk through its tunnels to the burial crypt (conditions permitting); we will also see the famous Sphinx. After lunch we will hope to visit Al-Fayoum with plenty of amazing natural beauty to be seen. Lake Qarun is the main sight for wilderness lovers with plentiful birdlife on display, including flamingos, and close by is the artist village of Tunis (where some of Egypt's best pottery can be purchased) Overnight: Holiday Inn Hotel Cairo - B /L/ D
DAY 4	SATURDAY, February 24	This morning a visit to the Egypt Museum, which is filled with amazing artefacts such as the treasure room of King Tutankhamen explore the marvels of the Egyptian Museum. Today we have a lunch cruise on the Nile River and if time permits some time at the Khan el-Khalili Cairo Bazaar for shopping. Overnight: Holiday Inn Hotel Cairo - B /L/ D
DAY 5	SUNDAY, February 25	This morning we fly to Sharm el Sheik which is located on the Red Sea. It's time to relax along the beaches and soak in the beauty of the Red Sea. Sharm el Sheik is famous for snorkelling the warm crystal clear waters filled with incredibly colorful fish so don't miss this opportunity. So enjoy, relax, stop and take your time for lunch at a local café. Overnight: Hilton Hotel, Sharm el Sheik - B/D
DAY 6	MONDAY, February 26	Another day to relax and enjoy, we have planned a boat ride on the Red Sea for your pleasure. Don't forget to pick-up a local food lunch maybe try a Turkish bath today or a massage the choice is all yours. Overnight: Hilton Hotel, Sharm el Sheik - B/D

ISRAEL

DAY 7	TUESDAY, February 27	<p>This morning we will fly to Amman and go directly to the Allenby Bridge and cross over into the Holy Land. Our first stop is the oasis of En Gedi where David hid from King Saul and cut off the corner of his robe, this oasis is amazing where you can explore the fresh water springs or walk the goat trails of the Ibex, it really is a beautiful place to explore and full of biblical history, so put on your hiking boots as we explore the Wilderness of Judah. Finally, some time to relax and enjoy the Dead Sea.</p> <p>Overnight: Oasis Hotel, Jericho - B /L/ D</p>
DAY 8	WEDNESDAY February 28	<p>A drive by Tel Jericho where only a mound of dirt remains, then we will view the Mt of Temptation from the valley below. A must stop at the glorious Sycamore Tree of Jericho followed by some duty free street vendor shopping.</p> <p>A visit to the Yad Va Shem Museum. Next we will see a Model of Jerusalem during the 2nd Temple period. Finally we will visit the Church of the Nativity at Manager Square.</p> <p>Overnight: Manger Square Hotel, Bethlehem -B /L/ D</p>
DAY 9	THURSDAY, March 1	<p>Today is a full, fun day! Starting with an early morning visit to the Mt of Olives, if we make it in time we will be able to catch the early shades of morning glowing over Jerusalem from the Mt of Olives. After some time enjoying the view we will begin the Palm Sunday walk down the steep incline to Dominos Flevit where Jesus wept over a rebellious Jerusalem. When we reach the bottom we will spend some time at the Garden of Gethsemane, so rich with history from the night Jesus was betrayed this place will be a truly moving experience. Next, a special treat; the David City Sifting Project where we will be able to sift through buckets of dirt that came from under the Temple Mount! We will look for artifacts spread across 2000 years! Maybe you will find something special! After dinner you are free to explore the shops of West Jerusalem.</p> <p>Overnight: Caesar Hotel, Jerusalem B/L/D</p>
DAY 10	FRIDAY, March 2	<p>If conditions permit, we have an early start today to visit the Temple Mount. These 14 hectares of sacred space is the most priceless piece of real estate in the world! It sits on top of Mount Moriah which is where Abraham almost sacrificed s son Isaac. Here was the location of the Temples of Solomon and Herod; the latter is where the infant Jesus was presented to the Lord by Mary an Jospheh. We will make our way to the Western Wall to pray and if you would like, place a handwritten prayer in the crevices of the stones. We will get to walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel and finish the day with communion at the beautiful Garden Tomb - a very moving, peaceful place. After dinner, you will get to explore Jaffa Road on your own - the heartland of Jewish Jerusalem.</p> <p>Overnight: Caesar Hotel, Jerusalem - B/L/D</p>

<p>DAY 11</p>	<p>SATURDAY, March 3</p>	<p>We have an early start today as we drive north to the Mediterranean Sea and Caesarea where Paul was held prisoner. It is here that the famous Aqueduct, build by Herod, resides.</p> <p>After lunch we hope to visit Mt Carmel and the wonderful Messianic Assembly where we will enjoy some worship and fellowship together. Following this we will head to Tiberias for the night.</p> <p>Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias- B/L/D</p>
<p>DAY 12</p>	<p>SUNDAY, March 4</p>	<p>Today we will walk through the Nazareth Village which depicts life int he time of Jerusalem, learn what live was really like! Here we will enjoy a Biblical lunch, only using ingredients from Biblical times. Not too far away is Mt Precipice which overlooks the Valley of Armageddon also known as the Gathering Place. Finally, and if time permits, a stop at the Arbel Lookout which will give you a breath-taking view of the Sea of Galilee at dusk.</p> <p>Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias- B/L/D</p>
<p>DAY 13</p>	<p>MONDAY, March 5</p>	<p>Today we head as far north as we possibly can to the Golan Heights where we will stop at the lower viewpoint of Mt Bental that overlooks Syria & Mt Hermon. Then to Tel Dan where the Children of Israel built the Golden Calf and where the cool water from the ice-capped Mt Hermon begins it's journey into the Jordan River. After lunch we will stop at explore Nimrod's Fortress, the biggest Crusade-era castle in Israel, a mountain-top stronghold spanning back to the 13th century. With views of much of the Golan, it is situated on a peak neighboring Israel's highest and only snow-capped mountain, Mount Hermon. The ruins of Nimrod Fortress are beautiful and well-preserved, a truly visible snapshot of history and a fun place to explore.</p> <p>Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias- B/L/D</p>
<p>DAY 14</p>	<p>TUESDAY, March 6</p>	<p>This morning we will enjoy a beautiful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee - a perfect way to start the day! We will experience Capernaum, Jesus' headquarters during His early years and the Mount of Beatitudes where He gave the most famous sermon in the world. We will enjoy a St Peter's fish lunch which is sure to delight your palate before we make our way to the Jordan River for a water baptism experience that you will never forget!</p> <p>Overnight: Restal Hotel, Tiberias- B/L/D</p>
<p>Day 15</p>	<p>WEDNESDAY, March 7</p>	<p>A late start begins with Shiloh where the Tabernacle of Moses resided for 369 years before it was hidden forever. This place has so much Bible history, imagine standing where the presence of God resided, it's a place to lay your burdens down and leave them behind. Enjoy a true Middle Eastern lunch in Sebastia before making our way back to Jerusalem for the night.</p> <p>Overnight: Caesar Hotel, Jerusalem - B/L/D</p>

DAY 16	THURSDAY, March 8	<p>This morning is yours to enjoy. You can explore the Old City on your own, shop or walk along Jaffa Road. Lunch is on your own, but there are many wonderful dining options near by. There will be late checkout for everyone and then for those of you who are heading home today you will make your way to Jordan where you will enjoy one last meal together in Amman before heading to the airport for your flight home!</p> <p>For those who are staying on for the Jesus Trail, we will wave goodbye to our friends after lunch and drive north to Nazareth.</p> <p>Overnight: Plaza Hotel, Nazareth - B/D or Royal Jordanian Airlines.</p>

DAY 18	SATURDAY, March 10	<p>We will continue our walk enjoying the Jesus Trail.</p> <p>Overnight: Reseal Hotel, Tiberias - B/D</p>
DAY 19	SUNDAY, March 11	<p>Today we will continue the Jesus Trail and we will have an open air church service along the way.</p> <p>Overnight: Reseal Hotel, Tiberias - B/D</p>
DAY 20	MONDAY, March 12	<p>Today is our final walking day. eW will climb down the Arbel Cliffs and walk along the shore of Galilee with our final destination being Capernaum.</p> <p>Overnight: Reseal Hotel, Tiberias - B/D</p>

TERMS + CONDITIONS

Please read the following 'Terms & Conditions' carefully because your acceptance of them is required in order to participate in the 'Jesus Trail Tour'.

DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT: In order to secure your place on the 'Jesus Trail Tour' a deposit of USD \$1200 per person is payable at the time of booking, along with a signed 'booking form.' Each participant needs to fill out their own 'Booking Form,' even if they are traveling as a couple/family (underage children can be covered by their parent's form). You will be given a confirmation of booking as well as a request for the balance of monies owed. The balance of payment needs to be sent no later than January 7, 2018 to the office. Failure to pay the balance by the due date means that we have the right to deem your booking as 'cancelled' and a cancellation fee will apply.

SINGLE-SUPPLEMENT: The tour land arrangements are based on 'twin share,' namely, two people sharing one hotel room. If a person is traveling alone and wants a room to them self, a 'single-supplement' extra charge must be paid. If a person is traveling alone, wants to go 'twin-share,' we will make every effort to identify a suitable partner. However, if no partner can be found, the 'single-supplement' charge still applies.

GROUP TOUR: The costs of the land arrangements are based on **25 people** traveling together, unless specified otherwise. Should less than this number be signed up, we reserve the right to adjust the price, cancel the tour or give a refund.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: You are strongly advised to obtain travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit. Your policy should include, but not be limited to cancellation, loss of deposit, loss of baggage, medical expenses, costs of repatriation to your home country if the tour is cut short or extended due to illness, or costs of returning to home country outside the tour due to the serious illness or death of a loved one. Please note that the 'Jesus Trail Tour', Teach All Nations Inc. and GEMM International Tours & Travel are not responsible for the expenses of uninsured travellers. LAND ARRANGEMENTS: All travel and accommodation is provided to tour participants by reputable third parties through GEMM International Tours & Travel, therefore it is important to remember that your place on the tour is subject to the liabilities and limitations imposed by these third parties.

COOPERATION: Participants are traveling to the Middle East as Biblical tourists/pilgrims. Therefore, it is imperative, and required, that full cooperation be given to the tour leader at all times.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Many photos are taken during the 'Jesus Trail Tour' Photos taken by us are sometimes used in promotion and or educational purposes. By signing the booking form you are agreeing that in the event that you are in any of these photos and it is used by Teach All Nations Inc. for promotion and educational that you have granted your permission.

CHRISTIAN PILGRIMAGE: The 'Jesus Trail Tour' is a Biblical tour open to members of the Body of Christ at large. It has a Charismatic flavor. Because this is a journey to Biblical sites for the purpose of devotion and education, all participants are required to honor Biblical/Christian/ traditional standards of morality and ethics at all times. Those who are physically impaired must have a care-giver traveling with them and assisting them at all times. Under-aged children are to be under the control of their parents at all times.

CANCELLATION: Should you find it necessary to cancel your reservation, you must advise us in writing. The letter of cancellation needs to be signed by the person making the original booking. No cancellation will be deemed active until the signed letter is received. Cancellation charges will be levied, depending on how much money was spent on your reservation and how close to the departure time the cancellation was made. They can vary from 30%, 60% or even 100% of the amount paid. Remember that cancellation charges might be compensated to you by your insurance company, depending on the reasons for the cancellation.

TERMS + CONDITIONS

REFUNDS: Refunds will not be given once the tour has commenced, nor will they be given if a part of the tour was not utilized, including those arranged by a third party.

RESPONSIBILITY: We will do our utmost to coordinate this tour for the benefit of all and accept responsibility for those actions that are a direct result of our negligence. However, we cannot and will not accept liability of any kind for acts, defaults, omissions, by negligence, damage, loss, theft of luggage and personal injury, accident, or illness or otherwise, involving any aspect of the tour outside our control or by third parties. Furthermore, the ‘Jesus Trail Tour’ will not accept responsibility for the following, including but not limited to: actions of the airlines, local tour operators, hotel operators, coach driver or company, or any other person or company providing services for this tour. We do not accept liability in contract or in tort (actionable wrong) for injury, damage, loss, delay, additional expenses or inconvenience caused, directly or not, whether by human error or an ‘act of God’ (force of nature), breakdown of equipment, strikes, theft, delay, cancellations or changes in itinerary or schedule, actions of the individual tourist, including failure to listen to instructions and warnings, or any other event beyond our control, or cannot be stopped even by our due diligence, including but not limited to terrorism, fire, war, riots, floods, very severe weather, acts of nature, acts of government, or other authorities, accidents, or mechanical failures.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: The participant agrees that in no event will the tour operator be liable for the results of participant’s use of these services, for participant’s inability or failure to obtain business or customers, or for indirect, special, or consequential damages. Participants further agrees that in no event will the total aggregate liability of the tour operator for any claims, losses or damages arising under this agreement whether in contract or tort, exceed the total amount paid by the participant to the tour operator during the preceding twelve (12) month period, even if the tour participant to tour operator has been advised of the possibility of such claim, loss, or damage except for losses arising from the tour operator’s gross negligence, fraud, or willful misconduct. The foregoing limitation of liability and exclusion of certain damages shall apply regardless of the success or effectiveness of other remedies.

MISCELLANEOUS This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws (excluding the law of conflict of laws) of the State of Victoria, Commonwealth of Australia. All disputes shall be resolved in Melbourne, Victoria. THIS AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES THE COMPLETE AND EXCLUSIVE STATEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES CONCERNING THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS AGREEMENT. If there is an issue involving the tour, see the responsible person directly and immediately (tour guide, team leader, tour organizer, etc.). Failure to deal with the problem promptly could make matters worse. If it involves the hotel and problems with the room, please see the front desk. Only if you cannot get satisfaction with the hotel that you should see a responsible tour person (tour guide is the first person to ask). We will do our very best to resolve issues on the spot. 2. In the unlikely event that you need to write about an issue, you have 28 days after the completion of the tour to document the problem. You can expect an initial response within 14-28 days after the letter is received. Any letters received after 28 days will be deemed ‘late.’ No action will be taken or response sent.
